

## **"Prescriptions of the Federation Française de Voile for an international event organized in France"**

### **RRS 25:**

*FFVoile Prescription:*

*For local, departmental, and regional competitions, posting of the general text of the standard sailing instructions will be considered as answering the requirement of RRS 25, if each competitor is provided with an appendix inherent to the specificities of the event and waters.*

### **RRS 60:**

*FFVoile Prescription (\*):*

*No fee or deposit can be required for lodging a protest, except for some measurement protests [see FFVoile prescription to rule 64.3(d)].*

### **RRS 64.3:**

*FFVoile Prescription (\*):*

*The protest committee may ask the parties to the protest, prior to checking procedures, a deposit covering the cost of checking arising from a measurement protest.*

### **RRS 68:**

*FFVoile Prescription (\*):*

*Damages compensation and any other action, arising from damages, not provided in the RRS is the entire competitors' responsibility.*

### **RRS 70.4:**

*FFVoile Prescription (\*):*

*In such circumstances, the written approval of the FFVoile shall be received before publishing the notice of race and posted on the official notice board during the competition.*

### **RRS 75:**

*FFVoile Prescription :*

*Competitors resident in France shall, according to the FFVoile regulation, prove their membership to one of the affiliated groups or approved establishments of the FFVoile, by showing a valid membership card.*

## **RRS 78.1:**

*FFVoile Prescription (\*):*

*The boat's owner or other person in charge shall, under his sole responsibility, make sure moreover that his boat comply with the equipment and security rules prescribed by the laws, by-laws and regulations of the Administration.*

## **RRS 86.3:**

*FFVoile Prescription (\*):*

*An organizing authority wishing to change a rule listed in RRS 86.1 in order to develop or test new rules shall obtain prior written approval of the FFVoile and report the results to FFVoile after the regatta. The authorisation of the FFVoile shall be mentioned in the notice of race, in the sailing instructions, and shall be posted on the official notice board during the regatta.*

## **RRS 87:**

*FFVoile Prescription (\*):*

*The sailing instructions of events up to the national level shall neither change nor delete any FFVoile Prescription. For international events organized in France, the prescriptions marked with an asterisk (\*) shall be neither changed nor deleted in the sailing instructions. (The official translation of the prescriptions, downloadable on the FFVoile website <http://www.ffvoile.org>, shall be the only translation used to comply with RRS 89.2(b)).*

## **RRS 88.1:**

*FFVoile Prescription (\*):*

*The FFVoile approval is required for the organization of an event by an unaffiliated body in conjunction with an affiliated club, the body being owned and controlled by the club.*

## **RRS 90:**

*FFVoile Prescription (\*):*

*The appointment of an international jury meeting the requirements of Appendix N or the appointment of any other jury without appeal is submitted to prior written approval of the FFVoile. Such notice of approval shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.*

## **APPENDIX F**

*FFVoile Prescription (\*):*

*Appeals shall be sent to the Fédération Française de Voile, Jury d'Appel, 17 rue Henri Bocquillon, 75015 Paris*

## **RRS F2.1**

*FFVoile Prescription (\*):*

*Upon receipt of a justified request from an organizer, the FFVoile may give its approval to use the following exceptional procedure:*

*“An appeal may be valid only if the appellant lodged intent of appeal at the latest two hours after having received the written decision of the protest committee”.*

*Such exceptional procedure shall be mentioned in the sailing instructions, after written approval of the FFVoile. This approval shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.*

## **RRS G2**

*FFVoile Prescription (\*):*

*Boats participating in a competition in France shall meet the requirements of RRS G1.*
